There is nothing to suggest that Mrs Wileman is anything other than capable of meeting her sons physical needs. All concerns have been based on the volatile and sometimes violent relationship between her and her husband. The couple to date have struggled to reconcile their differences or maintain a separation, however, Mr Wileman is currently in custody and Mrs Wileman has filed for divorce. Mrs Wileman needs to accept that Lucas has suffered emotionally from witnessing domestic violence and would benefit from professional therapeutic intervention to address this. Mrs Wileman is also likely to need advice in parenting a child who has had these experiences.
